Throughout 2025, PCH will complete 53 major projects on more than 40 homes—not counting emergency, corrective, and preventative maintenance issues that may arise. Some projects include:

- Flooring for 9 homes
- 7 new roofs
- Painting the exterior & interior of 5 homes
- Sliding doors and windows for 5 homes
- · 4 hot water heaters
- Siding for 4 homes
- 3 HVAC systems
- 2 bathrooms
